| <p>4.14.1 An emergency tiller capable of being fitted quickly to the rudder stock where the normal method of steering is other than by a strong tiller fitted directly to the rudder stock shall be provided.</p> <p>4.14.2 Crews must be aware of alternative methods of steering the boat in any sea condition in the event of rudder loss.
